

NOTICE FOR BIDS

The Village of Bedford Park, Illinois will receive sealed proposals for the following improvements.

PART I. TIME AND PLACE OF OPENING BIDS

Sealed Proposals for the improvement described herein will be received at the office of the Village Clerk of Bedford Park, 6701 South Archer Road, Bedford Park, Illinois, 60501 until **10:00 A.M. on Wednesday, July, 26, 2017**, and publicly opened and read aloud at that time.

PART II. DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The proposed work is officially known as:

NARRAGANSETT AVENUE RESURFACING

And is further described as following:

Removal of existing surface, installation of hot-mix asphalt surface and binder courses, base patching, curb and gutter and sidewalk removal and replacement along with improvements to drainage structures, and sewer point repairs.

PART III. INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- A. Plans and proposal forms may be obtained at the office of the Village Engineer, **HOEFFERLE-BUTLER ENGINEERING, INC.**, 8714 South Roberts Road, Hickory Hills, IL. 60457 for a non-refundable fee of \$40.00.
- B. All work will be in conformance with the latest editions of the STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR WATER AND SEWER MAIN CONSTRUCTION IN ILLINOIS and the STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, and all revisions thereto.
- C. Only bidders qualified by previous experience within the Village or bidders that can present an Illinois Department of Transportation pre-Qualification certificate upon picking up plans will be entitled to receive plans and submit proposals.
- D. All proposals must be accompanied by a bank cashier's check, or bank draft, certified check or bid bond for not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount of the bid.

PART IV. APPLICABLE FEDERAL AND STATE REQUIREMENTS

- A. All laborers and mechanics employed by the Contractor or Subcontractor(s) on construction for this project shall be paid wages at rates not less than those prevailing as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

- B. All contracts and subgrantees for construction for construction or repair shall include a provision for compliance with the "Copeland Anti-kickback Act" (18U.S.C. Section 874) as supplemented in Department of Labor Regulations (29 CFR Part 3).
- C. Contracts shall include a provision for compliance with Section 103 and 107 of the Contract Work hours and Safety Standards Act (40 U.S.C. Sections 327-330) as supplemented by Department of Labor Regulations (29 CFR Part 5).
- D. Contract shall include a provision for compliance with the Employment of Illinois workers on Public Works Act codified in 30 ILCS 570-1 (West 1996). If at the time during the term of this contract is executed or if during the term of the contract, there is excessive in Illinois as defined in the employment of Illinois Workers on Public works Act, 30 ILCS 570-0.01 et seq., as two consecutive months of unemployment exceeding 5%, the contractor agrees to employ Illinois laborers. An "Illinois laborer" is defined as any person who has resided in Illinois for at least thirty(30) days and intends to become or remain an Illinois resident. The Act relies on and incorporates theBureaus of Labor Statistics and its monthly publication of employment and unemployment figures. These figures may bereviewed in the Bureau's Web site at www.bis.gov/eag/.
