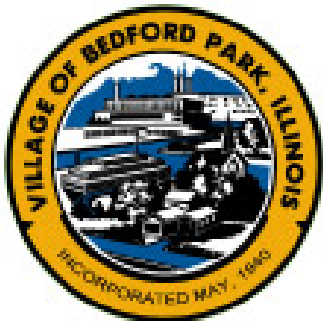

## Independent Accountant's Report on Compliance

To the Honorable Village President and  
Members of the Board of Trustees  
Village of Bedford Park, Illinois

We have examined management's assertion, included in its representation letter dated May 29, 2020, that the Village of Bedford Park, Illinois (the "Village") complied with the provisions of subsection (q) of Section 11-74.4-3 of the Illinois Tax Incremental Redevelopment Allocation Act (Illinois Public Act 85-1142) applicable to the Village's 65th Street TIF Funds during the year ended December 31, 2019. Management is responsible for the Village's assertion and for compliance with those requirements. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on management's assertion about the Village's compliance based on our examination.

Our examination was conducted in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants and, accordingly, included examining, on a test basis, evidence about the Village's compliance with those requirements and performing such other procedures as we considered necessary in the circumstances. We believe that our examination provides a reasonable basis for our opinion. Our examination does not provide a legal determination on the Village's compliance with statutory requirements.

In our opinion, management's assertion that the Village of Bedford Park, Illinois complied with the aforementioned requirements for the year ended December 31, 2019 is fairly stated, in all material respects.
