VILLAGE OF BEDFORD PARK

“HOW WE BEGAN”

The Village of Bedford Park was incorporated as a municipality in June of 1940, with its boundaries including not only the vast acreage housing the Argo Plant of Corn Products Refining Company and adjacent industrial properties, but also the 65th Street manufacturing area of the Clearing Industrial District.

The history of Corn Products can be traced back to the winter of 1907 and 1908, when the company first sent representatives into the area to investigate a site for its new plant. To accommodate the employees of the newly developed Corn Products Company a housing project was developed which was named for the first president of the company, Mr. E.T. Bedford, and the community began in 1919. The year 1924 saw the formation of the Bedford Park improvement club. Under the guidance of this pioneer citizen organization, the community grew and developed into a highly regarded area. The capable administration of civic affairs by its citizens was a prime factor in the growth and development, which in later years led to its prominent position as an ideal residential community.

The history of the Clearing Industrial District can be traced back as far as 1890, when Mr. A.B. Stickney, then president of the Chicago-Great Western Railway started making plans to meet the growing problem of the interchange of freight cars between the railroads in Chicago. He planned to acquire a tract of land three miles square, which was to be laid out with tracks, yards and industrial sites in such a way as to facilitate the interchange of freight. In 1912 the “Clearing Yards” were purchased by the newly organized Belt Railway, which became the joint property of the 13 principal railroads then terminating in Chicago.

The industrial district has grown and prospered over the years and now includes not only the 65th Street district but also the Cicero Avenue Corridor, and an area referred to as the 73rd Street Industrial District. Business and industry gave birth to the Village of Bedford Park, and through dedication and perseverance as well as a vision for the future, both the residential and industrial sections of the village can continue to benefit by this unique residential industrial relationship.

- The Village of Bedford Park Public Works Department is assigned the task of maintaining the village streets, sidewalks, trees, alleys, sewers, garbage removal services, and all other village owned buildings and grounds areas.
- **In the spring to fall during the hours of 8:30 am-1:00 pm (weather permitting), the north side public streets will be swept on Thursdays and the south side public streets will be swept on Fridays.** Signs reflecting these restrictions are posted throughout the residential area. Please keep in mind that the Village does have an ordinance in place which states: "It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on any public street or portion thereof in the Village at any time when such street is being cleaned." Therefore, police officers will be issuing tickets if vehicles are not removed from the public streets during this time. Residents can park in the Village Hall parking lot or on the north property during street sweeping. With the vehicles off the streets, the Public Works Department will be able to clean the streets efficiently.
- Snow removal is a duty of the Public Works Department. When snow removal is necessary, due to a snowfall of 2 inches or more, vehicles parked on the streets must be removed to allow for efficient removal on all residential streets.

To schedule a repair service, contact the Village Hall at (708) 458-2067 or email info@villageofbedfordpark.com The Village Vehicle Repair Program will provide basic automobile maintenance work for resident homeowner's vehicles that are registered in the Village of Bedford Park. The resident homeowner will pay for the cost of parts and materials to perform the maintenance work. There will be no labor cost. Each vehicle registered in the Village is limited to \$1,000 worth of work per year, again the cost of the work will be for parts and materials only including sales tax. The one-year time frame will be consistent with the vehicle registration cycle, July 1st through June 30th. Scheduling of repairs will be conducted by the Director of Vehicular Services. No loaner vehicles will be offered. Eligible work includes:

- Oil changes
- Brakes
- Tire Rotation
- Battery work
- Changing of headlights and wipers
- Serpentine Fan Belt, and
- Any other repair as deemed appropriate by the Director

Parking Incentive

In conjunction with the "Village Automobile Repair Program", the Village will also be offering an additional parking incentive to the program. As parking remains an issue for homeowners on residential streets, the Village is continually attempting to remedy the issue. The Village will be offering a \$200 credit towards the \$1,000 worth of yearly cumulative cost of parts and materials including sales tax that the resident is responsible for paying under the "Village Automobile Repair Program", if the resident agrees not to park that vehicle on the street during the overnight hours of 1:00am to 6:00am. The guidelines for the incentive are as follows:

1. The resident must enroll in the incentive program when renewing their vehicle registration sticker. The vehicle registration fee will be waived for vehicles enrolled in the program. The deadline to enroll in the program is July 31st.
2. Vehicles enrolled in the program will receive an additional village vehicle sticker that will be affixed to the rear window of the vehicle by a village representative.
3. A homeowner may enroll up to 4 vehicles that are registered to their address. This incentive does not apply to renters.
4. Repair costs are cumulative from July 1st – June 30th each year and will be deducted from the \$200 credit each time the vehicle is serviced.
5. Once the \$200 credit is exhausted, any additional cost of repairs (parts and materials only including sales tax) are the responsibility of the resident homeowner.
6. If the full \$200 credit is not used within the July 1st – June 30th yearly program cycle, it will expire and it will not be carried over to the next renewal period nor will there be any refunds issued.
7. All work must be completed by the Director of Vehicular Services.

➤ RESIDENTIAL STREET PARKING:

Overnight parking on Village residential streets (65th St., 65th Pl., and 66th St.) between the hours of 1:00am and 6:00am will be limited to vehicles that are displaying a current “on-street” Village vehicle sticker and to any guest who has received authorization from the Bedford Park Police Department. Overnight Parking authorization will be limited to one per household, per night. A household will be limited to 21 days of guest parking annually between July 1st and June 30th. As a result of the proximity to the park and the school, the current parking regulations on 66th Place will remain in effect.

NORTH 40 PARKING LOT: Overnight parking (1am-6am) in the parking lot north of the I&M Canal Visitor Center (“North 40” parking lot) will be limited to residents only. A vehicle parking in this lot overnight (1am–6am) must display a valid Village vehicle registration sticker or must have obtained authorization from the Bedford Park Police Department. There will be no yearly household limit for parking in this lot.

67th STREET PARKING / VILLAGE MUNICIPAL CENTER PARKING LOT: There will be no restrictions for parking on 67th Street or parking in the Village Hall parking lot.

➤ REQUEST A VACATION HOME WATCH

If you are traveling away from your home for more than a day or two, you can request a vacation watch of your home by the Police Department. Requests can be made online or by contacting the Police Department non-emergency number (708-458-3388). Homes on the watch list will be monitored by Police Officers during their routine patrols of the neighborhood. It should be understood, however, that the Bedford Park Police Department will make every attempt to periodically check your residence. Factors such as heavy call volume and/or officer availability may affect how often your property may be checked.


At the regular scheduled board meeting on Monday, March 14, 2022, Stickney Public Health District entered into an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement with the Village of Bedford Park to provide public health services to their residents on the same basis and under the same conditions as the residents of Stickney Township.

Effective April 1, 2022 residents of Bedford Park will be entitled to Public Health Services, which shall be defined as any health related service, or treatment, which is provided at any of our health clinics. These services, which are subject to change, shall include:

- Routine office consultations
- Dental Services
- Pregnancy Testing and Counseling
- WIC (Women, Infant, and Children) Services
- Podiatry Services
- Immunizations
- HIV & STI Testing
- Behavioral Health Services
- Home Health Services
- Lab Testing; and
- TB, Lead, Cholesterol, Blood Pressure & Diabetic Screenings.

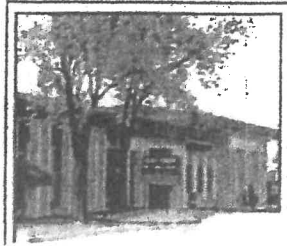
Any fees for services provided to residents of Stickney Township shall be applicable to the residents of Bedford Park as well.

Stickney Public Health District

Eligibility

Residents 18 years of age and older need to obtain a Stickney Township identification card to obtain services. Proof of residency is required to obtain this card.

Requirements include:

- Government issued ID Card.
 - Driver's License
 - State Id

Three current proofs of residency may include:

- Real Estate Tax Bill
- Current Lease Agreement
- Current utility bill
(Gas, electric, phone)
- Current Credit Card statements
- Current Bank Statement
- Any current bill that include name and address

The address and name needs to match on all forms being used for the proof of residency.

Proof of Residency is renewed on a yearly basis.

Please contact any of the offices or stop by during business hours for more information.

No medical services can be provided to any person under the age of 18 unless accompanied by and consented to by a parent or legal guardian.

The physician at this office does not fill out insurance forms, workman's compensation forms, disability forms, Secretary of State Driver's License re-instatement Forms, Fit for Duty Forms or Certificates of Religious Exemptions.

I-CARE or the Illinois Comprehensive Automated Registration is used by this facility. If you wish to "Opt Out" of this Program, please inform the staff.

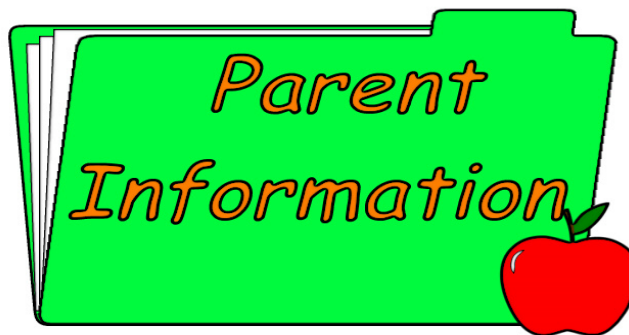
