As the Board recalls, they're asking for a Class 6 SER. and their accountants have figured out what the financial implications would be to the taxing districts and the taxpayers so we came back with a possible alternative which would include a possible water rebate to Ingredion. They're the second largest water customer, I believe, so we're looking at that That would help us alleviate the burden on the taxpayers and the tax districts also. So that --We're still looking at that. They haven't said yes to the offer, but we have to look at it a little further.

We also indicated we'll waive permit fees, the building permits fees, which how much they will be, I'm not too sure; but we said we would waive those. They are in an enterprise zone so they do get certain State benefits and local benefits that would be available to them. We said the Class 6 SER would
