SHEEHAN: It was a pretty quiet month, so I figure I can just touch on a 4 Starting with the Cash Balance. 5 couple items. Total Cash Balance at the end of July was 98.9 million 6 which is an increase in 2 million from 90.6 million at the end of June 30th. The majority of this increase 8 9 was due to the second installment property taxes 10 received in July. Property taxes received are at 11 81 percent of the budgeted amount for July. 12 General Fund Revenue was 33.1 million and 13 Expenses were 21.3 million resulting in 11.8 million 14 Excess Revenue over Expenditures through July. 15 Expenses for the General Fund by Department 16 are running in budget through July also. 17 Event Center Operations Revenue was 18 \$346,000 for July with \$321,000 of Expense resulting 19 in a net income of \$25,000 for the month of July. 20 Year to date the net income is at \$61,000. 21 And that's July. 22 VILLAGE PRESIDENT BRADY: Okay.
