14 MR. GEORGE: Good evening, Mayor, Trustees. We  
15 are going to present for you tonight the August 2024  
16 Financials that Marilyn and the team put together.  
17 Everybody knows Marilyn pulled all this information  
18 together and I'm reporting the information here.

19 So Statement of Cash and Investments for  
20 the month of August. We began -- We ended the month  
21 with Cash of 85.7 million, Investments of 18.4 million  
22 with total Cash and Investments of 104.3 million.

23 Our Summary of Funds Report lists out all  
24 of our Cash Revenue and Expenses by Fund. Our total,

1 we began the month across all funds with 98.9 million.  
2 We had revenue that came in for the month of  
3 15.6 million. Expenses and other sources and uses of  
4 10.4 million and again ended the month with  
5 104.3 million in Cash and Investments across all  
6 Funds.

7 Highlights for the General Fund. We're  
8 eight months out of the year so we'd expect to compare  
9 to budget to be about 66.7 percent. Revenues for the  
10 month were 7.1 million. Year to date, we're at  
11 40.2 million. We're at 87 percent of budget. The  
12 significant component there that's flipping things is  
13 our Property Tax Collection. We had Property Tax  
14 Collection that comes through. We're at 97 percent of  
15 our budget so that's inflating that percentage.

16 The highlights on the Revenue side. We had  
17 Property Tax Collections of 2.8 million in August.  
18 That brought our total to 16.5 million year to date.  
19 So again, we're at 97 percent of budget.

20 Hotel Tax Dollars. We had \$666,000 in  
21 August. 4.- -- 4 million year to date. For the  
22 month, we're about 3.7 percent more than last year and  
23 flat year to date.

24 We also had a TIF surplus distribution that

1 came through in August for the 65th and Cicero TIF.  
2 It was \$2 and half million that the County  
3 redistributed of which 725,000 came through to the  
4 Village. And then we also had Bank of New York,  
5 1.1 million of distributions of excess pledged of  
6 Hotel Cash Dollars. In August, year to date, we're at  
7 \$3 million of distributions, back excess hotel pledged  
8 tax dollars.

9           The departmental highlights, we had -- the  
10 Police Department had expenses for the month of  
11 886,000. Year to date, they're at 6 million, so  
12 they're at 69 percent of budget.

13           The Fire Department, 1.4 million for the  
14 month, 7.8 million year to date, 66 percent of budget.

15           Administration, we're at 244,000 for the  
16 month, 2.4 million year to date, 70 percent of budget.

17           Residential Services, we had \$206,000 paid  
18 to the residents back for property tax rebates. That  
19 came through in August.

20           Building Department, we're at 24,000 for  
21 the month, 213,000 year to date, 59 percent of budget.

22           Street and Bridge, 33,000 for the month,  
23 299,000 year to date, 57 percent of budget.

24           And then the Vehicle Services, 26,000 for

1 the month, 178,000 year to date, and 63 percent of  
2 budget.

3 Overall, the General Fund had revenues for  
4 the month of 7.1 million, expenses of 4 million. It  
5 had excess revenue over expenses of 3.1 million. And  
6 year to date, we're at 40 million of revenue and  
7 25 million in expenses, so 14.9 million excess.  
8 Obviously, that's property tax dollars that have come  
9 in ahead of -- on time, but ahead of the budgeted  
10 allocations. So that's a big component of that.

11 Water Fund. Water Fund for the month had  
12 revenue of 5.7 million, expenses of 4 million, excess  
13 of revenue over expenses 1.7 million. And year to  
14 date, we're at 30.2 million in revenue, 6.5 million in  
15 expenses, 3.7 million excess of revenue over expenses.

16 Our Water Capital Project Fund. The  
17 highlight there, we had 916,000 of expenses in the  
18 month related to the 70th Place Central to Leamington  
19 Water Main Project that came through in August.

20 And then lastly, our Event Center. The  
21 Event Center had combined between Village operations  
22 and SFM operations revenue for the month of 128,000,  
23 expenses of 251,000. So excess of expenses over  
24 revenue of 123,000. Year to date, we're at

1 2.6 million in revenue, expenses of 2.9 million,  
2 excess of expenses over revenue of 300,000. Overall,  
3 SFM operations are still running about 105,000 better  
4 than budget even though we're at that deficit, but it  
5 ahead of where we were from a budget perspective.

6 Those are the highlights on the August  
7 financials. Questions? Comments?

8 VILLAGE PRESIDENT BRADY: John, we're in good  
9 shape?

10 MR. GEORGE: Yes. THE Village is in sound  
11 financial position. That's a continued conversation  
12 we have around managing reserves, capital projects,  
13 needs of future projects. So yes, a strong financial  
14 position continues to be a focus.

15 TRUSTEE STOCKS: I have a question, maybe it's  
16 for Marilyn. How are we doing on our investments on  
17 the yield?

18 MS. CURNUTTE: The investments have rebounded  
19 from the pandemic. We book that activity quarterly.  
20 So you'll see the third quarter on the September  
21 financials, but we're doing very well.

22 MR. GEORGE: As of August, we have about a  
23 million dollars of unrealized gains on the  
24 investments.

20 TRUSTEE WESOLOWSKI: Do they have a Go fund Me  
21 page?  
22 VILLAGE PRESIDENT BRADY: I think the school was  
23 doing their own fund for it, but it was in the paper.  
24 Tom, anything else?

1 TRUSTEE PALLARDY: No. That's all. Thanks,  
2 Mayor.

3 VILLAGE PRESIDENT BRADY: Okay.

19 pushed off to the week after Thanksgiving pending  
20 Hometown Electric's schedule.  
21 We are moving along on the 65th Street  
22 widening by Moretti's. So if you were going toward  
23 the Event Center, there's a lot of construction right  
24 now so please be extra cautious and aware. We've got

1 Gas N Wash. We've got the street widening. We've got  
2 Wyndham a little bit further down the block. We've  
3 got Chicago Pallet. 65th has got a lot happening at  
4 the moment.

5 And I think that's pretty much it for my  
6 update, so thank you.

7 TRUSTEE WESOLOWSKI: How is the tarps on  
8 66th Place, the blue tarps, the house?

9 MS. HUFF: The houses? The first house closest  
10 to the corner here --

11 TRUSTEE WESOLOWSKI: Second house.

12 MS. HUFF: -- or second house, yeah, they are --  
13 they have their permit application and am waiting for  
14 the insurance information from the contractor and then  
15 they'll be going. The house at the end of the block,  
16 they have their permit, but I don't know why they  
17 haven't started Construction yet.

18 TRUSTEE WESOLOWSKI: End of block meaning, what's  
19 on the end of the block?

20 MS. HUFF: Wasn't there a second house further  
21 down the block?

22 TRUSTEE WESOLOWSKI: I'm just talking about the  
23 blue tarps.

24 MS. HUFF: Okay. The second house, their

1 application is in. Their building plans have been  
2 approved. They went through BNP because it's a  
3 structural issue at this point, it wasn't just the  
4 couple repair shingles, it was a whole structural  
5 issue. So they've gotten the approval, they have  
6 approved architectural plans, but I'm just waiting on  
7 the insurance paperwork, like the contractor's  
8 insurance. So if they damage anything of Village  
9 value, we can hold them accountable.

10 TRUSTEE WESOLOWSKI: Did we give them a deadline  
11 on this?

12 MS. HUFF: Yes. Yes. So as long as they -- what  
13 we've worked out with them, as long as they kept  
14 showing that they're moving forward, which they have  
15 been, I've only been waiting a week for the insurance  
16 papers. So it's not, like, I've been -- I mean,  
17 they've been working continuously. They re-submitted  
18 plans three times and they have been working forward.  
19 They did have a fine incurred against them -- a town  
20 ordinance ticket against them and that really jumped  
21 started them back up.

22 TRUSTEE WESOLOWSKI: Thank you. Thank you, Hon.  
23 Thank you.

24 VILLAGE PRESIDENT BRADY: Okay. Marilyn ...

1 MS. CURNUTTE: I have nothing else. Thank you.

2 VILLAGE PRESIDENT BRADY: John ...

3 MR. GEORGE: Nothing. Thank you.

4 VILLAGE PRESIDENT BRADY: Kevin ...

5 MR. PACHECO: Yes. There was an incident about a  
6 week ago with the trustees receiving a couple  
7 unverified e-mails from the Mayor. We did discover  
8 those were false, they weren't from the Mayor. My  
9 recommendation is that moving forward any type of  
10 e-mails that are coming to the Village -- your Village  
11 account that is not verified, don't open it, please.  
12 In this case, it was dbrady@outlook.com which can be  
13 confusing. Any e-mail within the trustees or the  
14 staff members will be from the Village of  
15 Bedford Park. So just be aware there's a lot of scams  
16 going around whether it's even phone calls or text.  
17 If you don't recognize the number, my recommendation  
18 is don't respond. Thank you.

19 (Overlapping talking.)

20 VILLAGE PRESIDENT BRADY: Okay. Dan ...

21 CHIEF JOHNSON: Thank you to the Board for  
22 considering the fire inspector position. Thank you.

23 We're going to bring Santa back in town  
24 here December 15th, it's a Sunday morning. He'll be

1 riding in on a fire truck for the children. We're  
2 going to have candy canes for everybody so hope to see  
3 everybody that day. That's all I have. Thank you,  
4 Mayor.

5 VILLAGE PRESIDENT BRADY: Okay. Tom ...

6 CHIEF HANSEN: Thanks for the approval of the  
7 license plate readers coming into the residential  
8 area. I think that those will be an asset to helping  
9 keep the community safe, so I do appreciate it.

10 TRUSTEE WESOLOWSKI: And, Tom, do you know what,  
11 I saw two people blow through my stop sign today, just  
12 blow through it.

13 CHIEF HANSEN: Yeah. We've had more cars in  
14 there. In the last two weeks, we've had over  
15 12 traffic stops in the residential area which is a  
16 lot.

17 TRUSTEE WESOLOWSKI: Just blowing through. Do  
18 you think we -- We can't put a speed bump there?

19 CHIEF HANSEN: As we get into the winter and  
20 plowing and stuff, it makes it difficult. Again, it's  
21 just -- I'm putting two cars in there to run traffic  
22 and I'm hoping word gets out and they see people  
23 getting stopped and we are writing tickets on them  
24 too, so I'm hoping that it helps.



1 TRUSTEE WESOLOWSKI: You don't think that stop,  
2 the one that -- that lights up like that?

3 CHIEF HANSEN: I think it's a lot of residents.  
4 I think they know the stop signs are there. It's not  
5 like they don't see it.

6 TRUSTEE WESOLOWSKI: Not even put their brakes  
7 on, just --

8 CHIEF HANSEN: No, I understand and you're not  
9 the only person I've heard from and it's something  
10 that we're aware of.

11 TRUSTEE WESOLOWSKI: I'm ready to do citizen  
12 arrests, I'll tell you.

13 CHIEF HANSEN: But those red lights, also at  
14 night they can be a bit much for when it's your house  
15 that's there.

16 TRUSTEE WESOLOWSKI: That's all right. My house  
17 is right there. I wouldn't mind it.

18 VILLAGE PRESIDENT BRADY: And a lot of residents  
19 think that we can put the speed -- or the cameras  
20 there to give them a ticket. We can't legally do  
21 that, only Chicago can do that.

22 TRUSTEE KENSIK: We can scare them.

23 VILLAGE PRESIDENT BRADY: The other thing that  
24 happened, there was a teen-ager that kind of lives

1 down by Terry that ran into two cars on 65th Place  
2 last week and damaged one truck and did severe damage  
3 to a car. The person -- The policeman was right there  
4 with the call. The person was not impaired in any way  
5 by the policeman's judgment. He was ticketed. And we  
6 have a lot of people that are -- need to go through  
7 driver's education again.

8 TRUSTEE PALLARDY: That wouldn't help.

9 TRUSTEE STOCKS: It probably wouldn't.

10 CHIEF HANSEN: Joe is on-line too.

11 VILLAGE PRESIDENT BRADY: Joe, do you want to add  
12 anything?
